1. Public Forum

One member of the public raised his concerns about vehicles leaving the Village Hall and speeding along Middle Street. This has been reported to the police but no return call received. The Clerk asked him to e-mail the details and this would be reported to the police. Councillor Byatt informed them that the Parish Council are members of the Community Speed Watch volunteer scheme and have recently purchased two Speed Indicator Signs. Issues of ASB can also be reported to NKDC ASB team.

The other member of the public at the meeting complained about the number of pot holes and the terrible state of the High Street. Councillor Wilson explained that the High Street was scheduled for re-surfacing in July 2017, however due to budget constraints this has been pushed out to 2019/2020. The Parish Council regularly report pot holes however members of the public can report direct to LCC.
