Please find below details from an email sent to both yourself and Cllr Ian Fleetwood on Friday 6th September, which BGPC have not yet received a response.

Thank you for meeting with Cllrs John Zubic, Sally Zubic and Malcom Speed in July. Last night Bardney Group Parish Council met to discuss your proposals to address highways issues in our area and please find below the response from our members;

- *Horncastle Road junction with Silver Street, outside the post office. BGPC agreed with your proposal for the H line to be extended by 2 metres.*
- *Station Rd between the Open Door Tearoom and the Gun shop. BGPC agreed with your proposal to install double yellow lines at this pinch point.*
- *Wragby Rd junction with Station Road. BGPC agreed with your proposal to install double yellow lines outside the butchers shop and the Nags Head pub.*
- *Thomas Kitching Way. BGPC would like phase 1 & 2 of Chestnut Homes estate to be brought up to the appropriate standard for road markings.*

With regards to Harvey Kent Gardens, BGPC agree with your suggestion that no changes are made in this area, as a TRO's would only impact elsewhere in the village.

BGPC would like to take this opportunity to thank Cllr Clío Perraton-Williams and yourself for visiting our village.
