They are building a crematorium on Lea Road which should be open next Autumn 2019.
A new policy- 'Customer First' which will improve customer services.
They are going to redesign the West Lindsey's reception area.
The scaffolding is coming down around the former Sun Inn.
The Roseway car park will reopen in September 2018. The toilets in the Roseway have been reopened already.
West Lindsey has won £1,800000. The money will be used as a heritage project. They have started to restore period shop frontages in the buildings on Market Street.
