LATEST CRICKET NEWS

The team has reached the top of the Division One table! On 22nd July Caythorpe scored 169, but Nocton made 172 for 2 when Miles Lynch got 51 not out. The match on 29th July was cancelled because of rain but on 5th August Nocton made the highest score in the whole league so far this season, with 346 for 7. Sleaford 2nds could only reach 112. On 12th August Caythorpe scored only 58 for 9 leading to another win for Nocton with 61 for no loss of wickets. The match on 19th August saw Nocton make 159 but Woodhall Spa could reach only 87 as they met Miles Lynch who took 7-17. Miles has now taken 24 wickets and Dylan has scored 717 runs, the most in the league. What a season so far for Nocton!!
