

Report to Nettleham Parish Council: December 11, 2017: Angela M White.

The Challenge and Improvement Committee considered the West Lindsey District Council involvement in Scampton Air Show and recommendations were made for the future.

The Prosperous Communities Committee considered the consultation on charging for Green Bins.

The council needs to save money in the next three years with reduced government income.

All the other district councils in West Lindsey charge for green waste.

Those who do not have a garden are subsidising those who do, when the service is free of charge.

The proposed charge of £35 for fortnightly collections from April to November inclusive is good value for green waste collection from your property.

The money saved can be used for other council services.

The Leisure, Culture, Events and Tourism group are meeting next week at the Trinity Arts Centre. This is to meet the new manager and to discuss the remit for the job description for the officer who will replace the retiring tourism officer.

I am involved in a new group of officers and councillors who will work with the Benjamin Adlard School in Gainsborough. This is to support the well-being of children who live in a deprived area of Gainsborough.

As district councillors for Nettleham and Riseholme, Giles and I have been invited to a meeting with the new Lincoln University Estates Manager at the West Lindsey offices. I presume that we will be discussing the revised plans for the Riseholme Hall campus.

After over a year of consultation and pressure, the cardiac centre at Glenfield Hospital in Leicester will remain open.
