



SAXILBY WITH INGLEBY PARISH COUNCIL

VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR

There is currently a vacancy on the Council and having been through the prescribed procedure, no election has been requested. The vacancy will therefore now be filled by the co-option process at the Parish Council meeting on 7th November 2018.

Should anyone wish to be considered for this vacancy, they should apply in writing to the Council at the address below, by 2nd November 2018. The application should be no more than one side of A4 and detail the applicant's background and reasons for wanting to serve on the Council.

Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if they are over 18, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a Euronational on the day of their selection and:

- a. on that day he/she is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- b. he/she has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in that area; or
- c. his/her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in that area; or
- d. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided in that area; or
- e. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided either in the parish or community or within three miles (4.8 kilometres) of it.

All applicants must be prepared to abide by the Council's adopted Code of Conduct – a copy of which can be provided on request.
