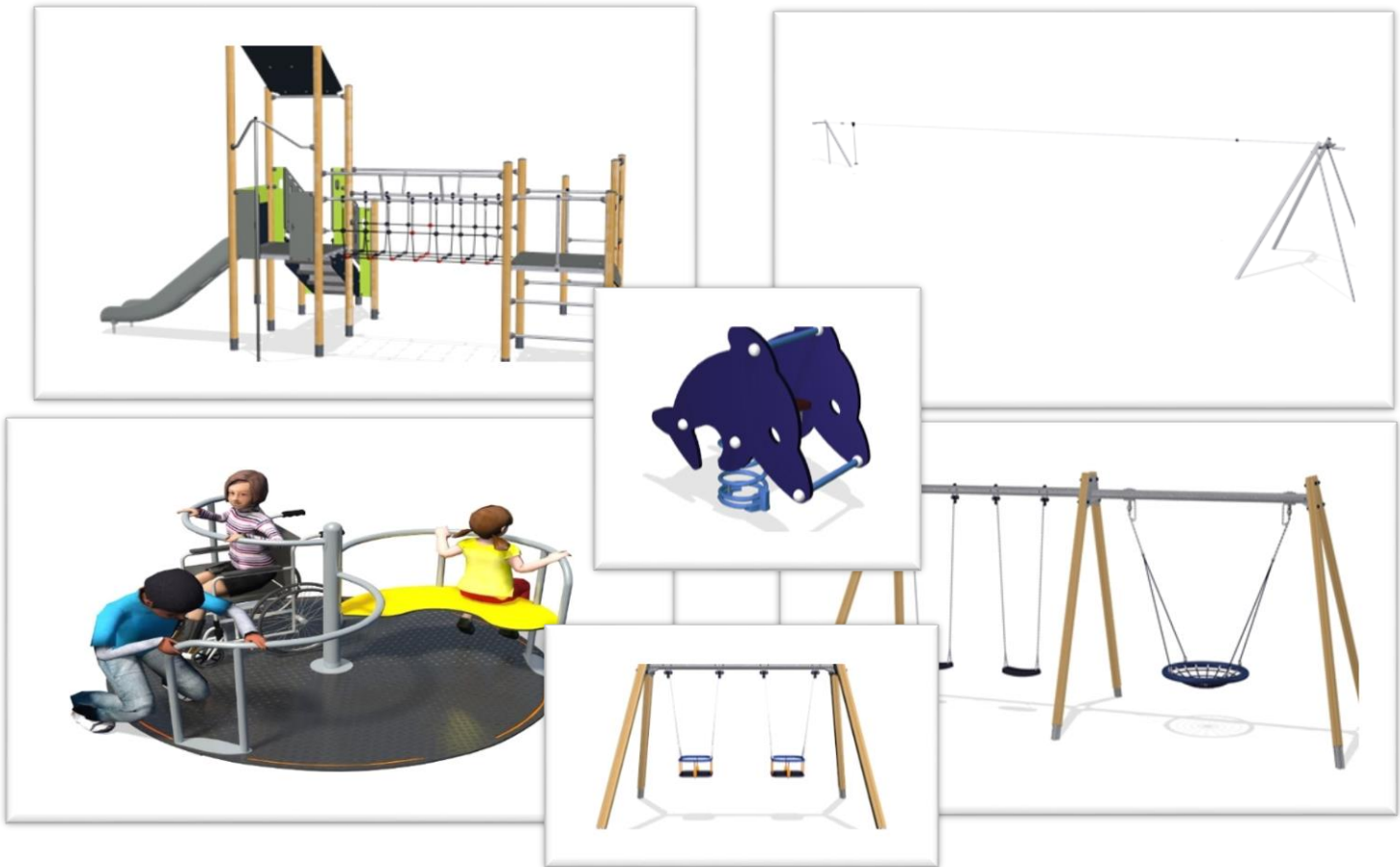


Memorial Field Play Area Update

Saxilby Play Hub

We are delighted to update you that the installation of the new play area will have begun by the time you are reading this. This is the culmination of a year of hard work particularly by members of the Play Area Working Group made up of volunteers and councillors, who have secured the required funds to enable the project to proceed and is based on consultation with children and parents.

The park will include a: Tower Unit, 25m Zip Wire (with ramp), Roundabout, Dolphin Springer and Toddler Junior and basket swings and have a mixture of bonded rubber mulch and grass mat surfacing.



Play equipment is very expensive and the cost of this equipment and the installation is **£53,000**. However, coming third in a national competition enabled us to secure extra discounts meaning we will pay **£37,000** for the project.

We are very grateful for all our supporters who have allowed the project to proceed including the National Lottery Awards for All (£9,550), WLDC Large Grant Scheme (£8,000) Lincolnshire Co-op Community Champions (£6,400), the Parish Council (£5,000), Tesco Bags of Help (£2,000), One Stop Carriers for Causes (£1,000) and local organisations including Saxilby Fire Station, Ladies Club and Kelder Gelder – Usborne Books. Also over £4,000 has been fundraised in one year through events, so thank to every one who has attended and volunteered at these events. It has truly been a community project.

The next stage is to fundraise to complete the project with landscaping including an access path, planting, benches, and fencing so please bear with us for the finished project.
